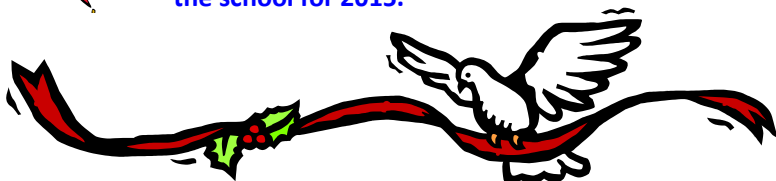
School Council
