Bendigo Bank

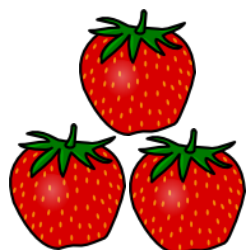
The Bendigo Bank visits the school each Monday at 8:50 – 9:10 am to process student banking. They are situated in the main Foyer. Applications forms are available at the office.

Sushi orders started back this week. Remember that orders need to be in no later than 12:00 on the Tuesday.

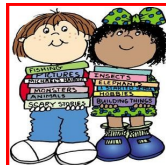


Perplexing Puzzles

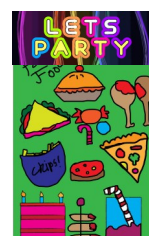


100 Days of School Celebration
