Fees cover transport, entry and eight 45 minute swimming lessons by qualified instructors at Bellarine Aquatic Sports Centre (BASC) Ocean Grove.

St John Ambulance will visit our school on Wednesday 2nd November to deliver free First Aid in Schools training to our students. Through the First Aid in Schools program,

trained St John presenters will lead students through tailored sessions on the importance of First Aid and what to do in the event of an emergency. Our junior students will learn about how to identify when there is an emergency, keeping themselves safe, and how to call for an ambulance. Senior students will learn about delivering CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) and the things they can do to assist in an emergency.

It will be conducted at the school and there is no cost involved.
