contributions!



If you'd like to help on the cake stall at the fair there's a couple of spaces left on the roster. It's a fun day on the cake stall. Happy baking!





Preparing for the Strawberry Fair is a great way to get to know other parents in the school. The Fair started as a community initiative and this is a wonderful tradition to uphold. There is already a lot of activity behind the scenes and as such, the committee thought it would be great to share, in a bit more detail, what area supervisors, helpers and contributors are up to - SO FAR! There is plenty to be done in the next three weeks and we will continue to offer insight into what is happening.

Be sure to support the fair by donating items, volunteering on the day and looking for your opportunity to help behind the scenes.

Preparing for the Garden and Produce Stall is certainly a team effort. We are lucky to have keen students and several parents who offer to help when seeds need to be planted and cared for, plus those who get in early to offer bulk donations of natives and other household plants. We have been busily preparing potted succulents; liaising with Landcare and the Ocean Grove District Men's Shed plus creating unique art pieces for the garden. Always thinking of the kids, the Garden and Produce Stall will offer an exciting COLOUR CHANGE garden potion, wands, as well as lovely products including a unique tea, wildflower seeds, art and donated seasonal produce. This includes a copy of the volunteer roster, Event Safety & Evacuation Procedure, Food Health & Hygiene Guidelines, Event Site Map and feedback sheet. If you need anything at all on the day, it should be in your Area Tub! Your supervisor will collect your tub from the hall the morning of the Fair. Please take a minute to fill out the feedback sheet at the end of the day, this will help us for the next WPS Strawberry Fair. Thank you!
