Chess

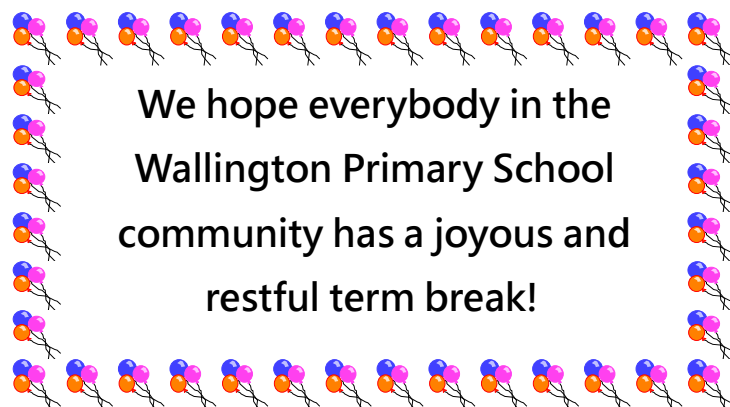
